**Directions to KPU Richmond Campus via Sky train:**

From the Waterfront Skytrain Station, take the Canada Line Skytrain (Richmond-Brighouse) to Lansdowne Skytrain Station. Disembark and walk south on No.3 Rd (about 80 meters) and take your first left on Lansdowne Rd. KPU Richmond will be on your left (approximately 650 meters). Head up the steps into the campus and go up one more story of steps once inside, then head left. The entire trip will take approximately 45 minutes from Waterfront Station (including walking).
